

WGSD TAXPAYERS

VOTE NO APRIL 7th

- Props S & W will raise residential real estate property taxes by 10.2%.
- WGSD is seeking its 5th and 6th tax increase - all within the past 10 years.
- WGSD already has the fifth highest school district tax rate in the St. Louis County.
- If Props S+W pass, WGSD will have the HIGHEST school district tax rate.
- WGSD already has a budget of \$57 million.
- WGSD has already received four tax increases since 2005.
- The average WGSD teacher salary is the 3rd highest average teacher salary in the county at \$67,443, plus benefits.
- The average WGSD administrator salary is the 4th highest average admin salary in the county at \$120,773, plus benefits.
- WGSD used \$850,000 of taxpayer money – left over from the 2010 bond issue for the high school – to purchase a commercial building at 3232 S. Brentwood Blvd, for storage, taking a \$30,000 yearly tax-generating property off the tax rolls.
- WGSD should Spend Wisely, don't raise taxes.
